



Manufacturer's Certification Great Lakes Window, Inc. Window & Door Products

The manufacturing operation of Great Lakes Window, Inc. is headquartered at 30499 Tracy Road, Walbridge, OH, 43465. Great Lakes Window manufactures custom vinyl replacement windows and patio doors that, when purchased with optional Low-E glass and an inert glass fill (argon or krypton, where required to meeting ENERGY STAR® criteria) in a double or triple glazed unit, meet or exceed the prescriptive criteria established by the IECC for all climate zones in which the window or doors are installed. These also meet or exceed ENERGY STAR program requirements (as in effect at the time of installation).

In accordance with Internal Revenue Notice 2006-26, and to certify the Great Lakes Window, Inc. windows and patio doors for purposes of the tax credits available under Section 25C of the Internal Revenue Code ("IRC"), Great Lakes Window represents that the following window and door products, when purchased with one of the optional glass packages (listed below), are "Eligible Building Envelope Component(s)" that qualify for the federal income tax credit allowed under Section 25C of the IRC:
